Image	Botanical Name	Common Name	Light Requirements	Water Requirements	Additional Info
	Aglaonema	Chinese Evergreen	Part shade/ Indirect light	Medium	Keep warm & moist. Do not like drafts; prefer warmth (no colder than 65 F).
	Alipinia zerumbet	Shell Ginger or Pink Porcelain Lily	Part shade to full sun	Keep soil moist	Can grow to 6 ft.
	Bromeliad neoregalia		Indirect light, moderate shade (can be acclimated to gentle light of eastern morning exposure)	Keep water in the central cup but flush frequently to prevent bacteria & odors.	An air plant that relies on roots to anchor. Prefers temperature of 55 F and higher, can tolerate as low as 40 F. Do not replot mature plants. After it flowers, it will produce plantlets around the base of the mature plant. Plantlets will form their own roots & can be separated from the mother plant. This is best done when the plant let is about 1/3 the size of the mother plant. Pot
	Calathea undulata metallica		Indirect, dappled light.	Medium (keep moist)	Native to South America. Relatively low maintenance indoor plant. Protect from freezing temperatures and draft. Water when top inch of soil feels dry.
	Costus sp.		Part shade (morning light/east facing window)	Medium (keep moist)	Need warmth, do not tolerate frost.
	Dieffenbachia		Low light (part shade)	Medium	Keep soil moist and mist to maintain humidity. Toxic to children & pets (due to high level of calcium oxylate).
	Euphorbia Phosphorea	Stick Euphorbia	Full sun	Low water	A moderately fast grower; does well indoors. The milky inner sap is said to become luminous when heated gently.

	Haworthia sp.	Haworthia	Part sun	Low water	White or yellow leaves can indicate too much sun. Does best with some light shade/ indirect sunlight. Slow growing.
	Musa acuminata zebrina	Blood Banana	Full to part sun	Medium to high water	Tropical, prefers warm temperatures and moisture. Can grow to 6'.
	Plectanthus coleiodes	Swedish Ivy White-edged	Part shade, filtered light.	Medium	Trim stems to encourage branching.
