Something you might find in a salad: Kale

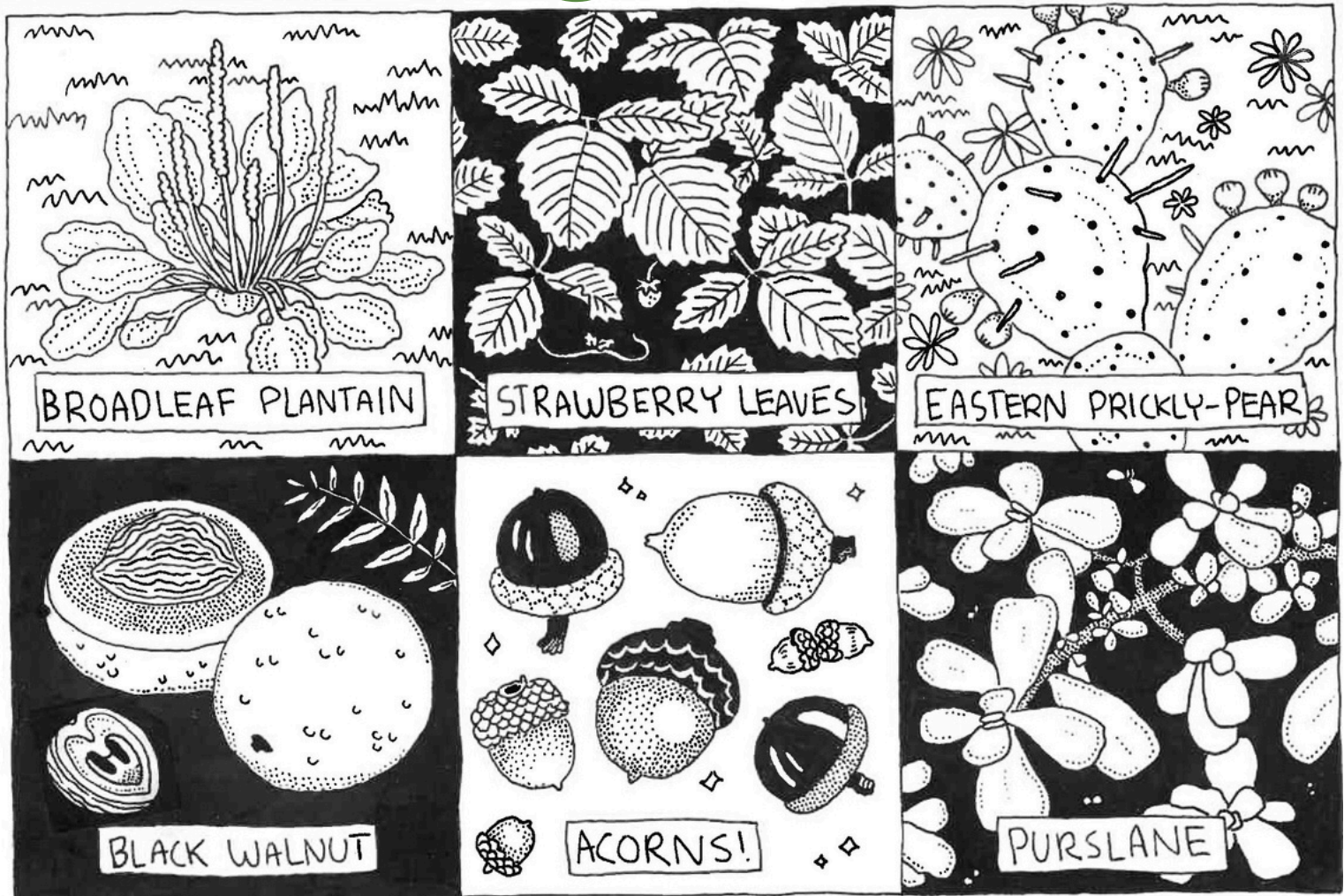
A veggie growing underground: Radishes, beets
